The Information

The **new and exciting** arrival to the village is the **Nissan Leaf**. A mid-sized family car which has **five doors, five seats**.



How far can it go?

With its 80kW AC Electric Motor the Nissan Leaf can venture approximately 80-100miles without the need for recharging.

How long does it take to charge?

A commercial 3-phase 440kW dc-input can charge the car to **80%** from flat in **around 30 minutes**.

The charge from a 220kW output takes **around 4-8 hours** to get the car from **flat to 100% charged**.

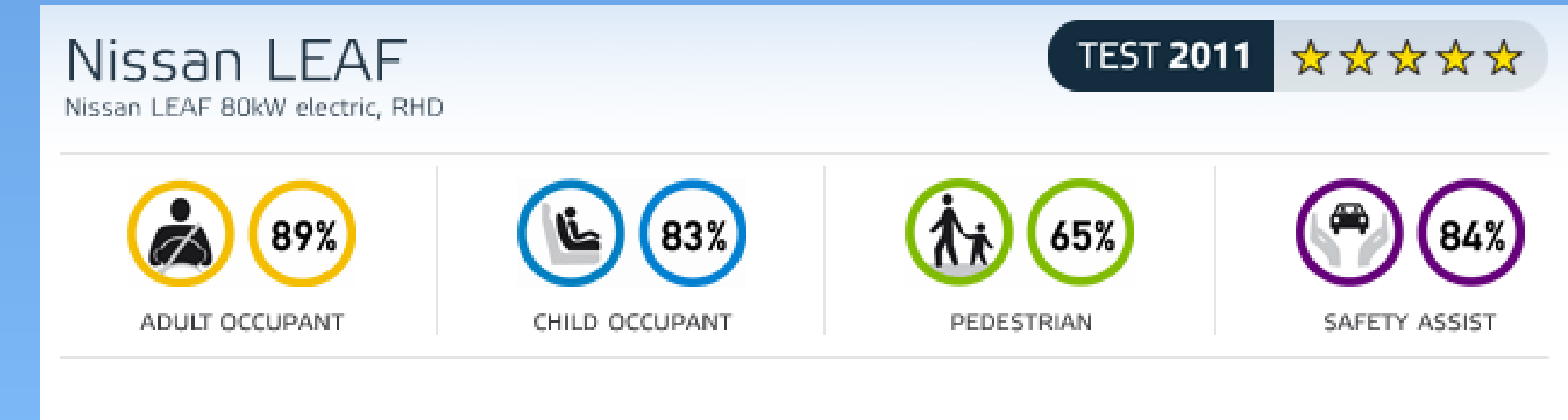

How do I book the car?

1. **Join up** to Commonwheels through the website www.commonwheels.org.uk or by calling **0845 602 8030**

 - Joining fee to the site: **£25** one-off payment
 - Returnable insurance deposit: **£150** or free if you sign up to direct debit
2. **Book** the car online or over the phone for a **minimum of 30 minutes**
3. Use your smart card and **drive off** in the new Electric Car!
